






Depression makes so many things hard. Things you used to take for granted: a good nights sleep, having goals, responding to someone's love, looking forward to the future. Is there any hope and help for those who are struggling with depression?

The training we had this weekend left us with some things to reflect on. One is Personal Preparation. First, by relying on God. We do this through prayer. Here is a daily prayer prompter to help you. Monday: Pray for Harvesters (Matthew 9:37,38) **Tuesday: Pray for Opportunities** (Colossians 4:3) Wednesday: Pray for Boldness (Ephesians 6:18-20) **Thursday: Pray for Clarity** (Colossians 4:3,4) **Friday: Pray for Receptive Hearts** (2 Thessalonians 3:1) Add this daily prayer reminder to your fridge or to your calendar or journal to pray weekly.



Second, we identified unbelievers. Do you know who your neighbors are? Think about your Spheres of influence. Family, Close friends, Co-Workers, Others. Take note of the non-believers whom you could build a relationship with.

Third, by praying for unbelievers. Prayer is at the center of every great evangelistic movement, and every movement is made up of everyday people. We have available a 30- day Prayer guide that will help you pray for the next 30 days.
