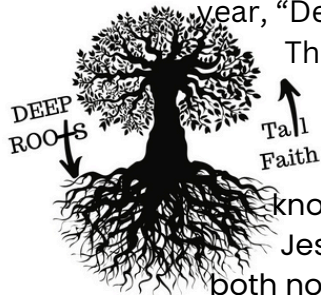


## About Us

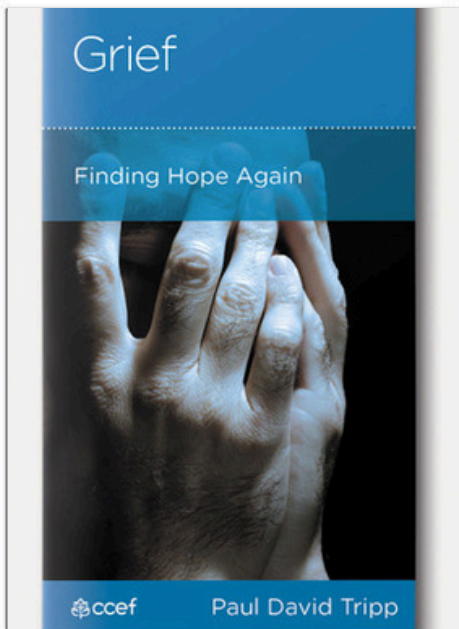

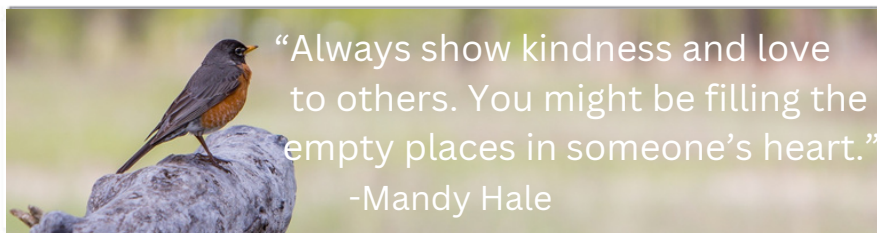
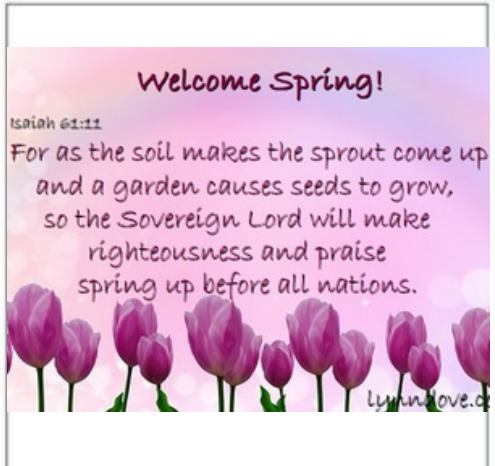
Identify unbelievers in your life. Do you know who your neighbors are?
